When the stone had been sealed by the Jews, and soldiers were guarding Thy most pure Body, Thou didst arise on the third day O Savior, granting life to the world; therefore the powers of heaven cried out to Thee O Giver of Life: Glory to Thy Resurrection O Christ. Glory to Thy kingdom. Glory to Thy dispensation, O Thou Who alone lovest mankind.

As God Thou didst arise from the tomb in glory, and didst raise up the world with Thyself; human nature hymneth Thee as God, and death hath vanished. Adam exulteth and Eve now freed from bonds, rejoiceth crying aloud: Thou O Christ art He Who granteth resurrection unto all.

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone 2

When Thou didst descend unto death O Life Immortal, then didst Thou slay Hades with the radiance of Thy Divinity; and when Thou didst raise the dead from the nether-most depths, all the powers of heaven cried out to Thee: O Life-giver Christ our God glory to Thee.

Thou didst arise from the tomb O all-powerful Savior, and Hades was terrified to behold this wonder; and the dead arose while creation on seeing it rejoiceth with Thee; and Adam also is glad, and the world O my Savior singeth Thy praises for ever.

Let those in heaven be glad, and let those on earth rejoice; for the Lord hath wrought might with His arm; having trampled down death by death, He is become the first-born from the dead. From the belly of Hades hath He delivered us, and hath granted to the world great mercy.

Thou didst arise from the tomb today O Compassionate One, and didst lead us up from the gates of death. Today Adam exulteth and Eve rejoiceth, and the prophets together with the patriarchs unceasingly hymn, the divine might of Thy power.

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone 4

When the women disciples of the Lord learned from angel, the joyous proclamation of the Resurrection, casting off their ancestral condemnation, they spake to the Apostles exultantly: Death is over-turned! Christ our God is Risen, granting the world great mercy.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone 4

My Savior and Deliverer as God, from the grave hath raised up the earthborn from their fetters; and He hath broken the gates of Hades, and as Master hath arisen on the third day.

Troparion of the Resurrection, Tone 5

O ye faithful let us hymn and worship the Word, Who with the Father and the Spirit is equally without beginning, and Who was born of the Virgin for our salvation; for He was pleased to ascend the Cross in the flesh, and to endure death, and to raise the dead, at His glorious Resurrection.

Thou didst descend into Hades O my Saviour, and having shattered its gates as the All-powerful One, Thou didst raise up the dead together with Thyself as the Creator. And Thou didst break the sting of death, and Adam was delivered from the curse, O Thou Who lovest mankind; therefore we all cry out: Save us O Lord.

The angelic powers were at Thy tomb; the guards became as dead men; and Mary stood by the grave, seeking Thy most pure Body. Thou didst overthrow Hades without being tried by it; Thou didst meet the Virgin O Thou Who grantest life. O Lord Who art risen from the dead glory to Thee.

Kontakion of the Resurrection, Tone 6

With the hand that originated life, Christ our God, the Giver of life, raised up all the dead out of the dark valleys, as He bestowed resurrection upon the human race; for He is the Savior of all, the Resurrection and the Life and the God of all.

Thou didst destroy death by Thy Cross, and didst open paradise to the thief. Thou didst transform the lamentation of the myrrhbearing women, and didst command the Apostles to proclaim, that Christ God is risen, granting the world great mercy.

No longer will the dominion of death be able to hold sway over men; for Christ hath descended, crushing and destroying its power. Hades is in bonds; the Prophets rejoice with one accord saying: A Savior hath come for them that have faith. Come forth ye faithful for the Resurrection.

From on high didst Thou descend O Merciful One; Thou didst accept burial for three days, that Thou mightest free us from the passions. O our Life and Resurrections glory to Thee.

Thou art risen from the tomb; Thou hast raised the dead and resurrected Adam. Eve exulteth at Thy Resurrection, and the ends of the world celebrate Thine arising from the dead, O Thou Whose mercies are many.
